■ 教育目的 (各クラス共通)

会話演習やプレゼンテーションを通じて、英語発信能力を高めることを目的とする。

■ 学習到達目標 (各クラス共通)

1. 会話演習やロールプレイング、テキストの練習問題等を行うことにより、日常生活において必要とされる英会話表現に習熟する。
2. 簡単なプレゼンテーションを英語で行う能力を身につける。

■ 授業内容

The focus of the course is on speaking English and students are expected to speak in English through either choral or individual repetition and reading out loud dialogues at every opportunity. Class will begin with warm up activities such as simple role plays or reporting to the class on what the student did over the weekend or what they plan to do on their next vacation in order for the students to loosen up in English. Afterwards, conversation based exercises and drills from the textbook will be presented and performed. Other skills which will be presented during the course to support the main objective of the course will include vocabulary expansion, development of listening skills, and reading comprehension. For final examinaion, students will be required to make a minute speech on a topic to be determined.

準備学習 (予習・復習) : In order to prepare for the lessons, students should review and practice the speaking exercises presented in the previous week. Also, if time allows, students should take every opportunity to involve themselves in other English language skills such as reading, writing, and listening to enhance their speaking skill.

成績評価方法 : Final examination = 50 % and participation and class room activities = 50 %
